





Dispersed into the product during the manufacturing process, ZPT anti-microbial prevents unpleasant odors, degradation, and discoloration as a result of microbial contamination. In addition to ZPT, our urethane topcoat also contains one of the highest concentrations of ceramic bead. This ceramic bead protects the urethane topcoat and provides excellent wear resistance. All backed by our non-prorated warranty. With classic hardwood aesthetics or fresh, modern designs, and with styles available in 2.5mm, 3mm and 5mm, our LVT collections are sophisticated and cost-effective.

J+J Flooring's SoundCheck[™] acoustical underlayment is a high-density acoustical underlayment that can be used with our LVT to increase the IIC rating and reduce floor-through-ceiling sound transmission in multilevel construction.

LVT

A Rigid Core LVT with click systems are prone to failures. Undulations in the subfloors that are not properly prepared will cause these failures. Some manufacturer's LVT have high quantities of cheap filler, which makes the product stiff and less flexible and more prone to crack or break with normal expansion and contraction of a building. Our LVT uses more vinyl and less filler, making it more flexible. It is also easy to pull up and replace if a plank gets damaged. Any damaged plank can simply be removed and replaced individually.

Our LVT also includes a ceramic bead which is added to the ultraviolet cured urethane clear coat for optimum scratch and scuff resistance. Simple routine sweeping and mopping is all that is needed for maintenance.

Since 85% of carpet soil and other contaminants come into the building on shoe soles, we also recommend using entryway systems at all entrances to trap and hold dirt and other pathogens before they are tracked into interior floor surfaces. A minimum of 15-ft. of entryway system is needed.



With ProTex[®], small soil particles, which would typically cause flooring to appear dull, are effectively removed by vacuuming or wet cleaning.

ColorLoc Plus[®] technology, standard on products manufactured with Encore[®] BCF space dyed nylon,* enables carpets to resist permanent staining from acid stain agents (coffee, sodas, tea, wine) and dispersetype agents (ketchup, mustard, betadine). ColorLoc Plus is also bleach-resistant,** protecting the carpet against color changes caused by inadvertent exposure to oxidizing agents; such as household bleach, benzoyl peroxide and hydrogen peroxide. That's an additional benefit that competing products do not match.





Noise Control


What type of flooring should you choose to make a difference for noise control?

Hard surface flooring absorbs little or no sound and has greater potential to transmit sound, contributing to a noisier environment. In contrast, soft surface flooring absorbs significantly more sound and transmits less sound, contributing to a quieter environment.

Reverberations are continuing effects of a sound, which happen when sound waves strike a surface and are reflected back into the space.


AIRBORNE NOISE REDUCTION Percentage of Sound Absorbed


• Soft surface flooring is better than hard surface flooring in reducing impact sound transmission, such as footsteps and objects dropping into spaces below.


